- The Team RUHS blog (www.teamruhs.org) was designed and created by the marketing team in Jan. 2023 as a new and unique employee engagement and communications platform.
- The Team RUHS blog and its content are managed by Marketing to ensure the content is fun, informative, engaging and appropriate.
- The Team RUHS blog currently consists of the following pages:
 1. *Home*
 2. *About You -- general news and highlights from staff*
 3. *News -- department news relevant to staff*
 4. *Events*
 5. *About Team RUHS*
- Content will vary and may change over time depending on views and analytics. Content will likely include:
 - staff recognitions and celebrations
 - work or personal anniversaries
 - staff events (i.e., Food Truck Tuesday, Grand Rounds, RUHS week)
 - general employee information (i.e., printer problems, new program address, employee flu shot campaign, RUHS week.)
- Marketing will pull content for the blog from various sources including STAR cards, Employee of the Month nominations, Weekly Administrative Announcements, emails, etc.
- Marketing will also promote the blog internally, via Weekly Admin Announcements, inviting all staff to visit the site and to submit content or 'stories,' by sending an email to marketing@ruhealth.org.
- Marketing reviews all submissions and makes the final determination as to whether the content is appropriate to post to Team RUHS. Marketing may revise/edit the content for brevity.
- Examples of inappropriate content include, but are not limited to:
 - impersonal or occupational RUHS content such as service outages, closures, and codes
 - the sale of items and/or fundraisers for non-RUHS programs/activities
 - content that promotes a political, social, or ideological view
 - content that does not reflect RUHS T.R.I.E.D values
 - content that negatively impacts a RUHS program, staff member, or Riverside County
 - content that includes patients or other confidential information
